Finally, in consideration of the permission and privilege of my child attending camp, I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless Camp Mason, it's staff and volunteers, from all losses, claims or actions that may arise from any event or incident not reasonably within its control while our child is engaged in any reasonable and normal, properly supervised camp activity. This does not nullify my right to seek legal redress if the camp or its staff are clearly negligent, but does assure the camp I will not hold it responsible for compensation for events not resulting from negligence but rather as a result of usual physical activity and sports in which we assume a voluntary risk by agreeing to allow our child to participate in.
