



Position: Life-guard

Job Description overview: A life-guard is responsible for primary life saving duties and accident prevention in and around the pool. Life-guards may also perform routine pool maintenance tasks such as chemical testing, vacuuming, and other such duties. Life-guards may be asked to instruct basic swim lessons. This position demands commitment to the values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility. It requires a consistently high energy level, a sharp eye, physical stamina, the ability to recognize swimmer distress and act quickly, and the desire to be a positive influence on the lives of children. Reports to the Aquatics Director.

Life-guards will be living off site. They are expected to arrive on time every day and be presentable and ready to work.

Additionally, the Life-guard will:

- Carry out daily area clean up
- Advise Aquatics Director on all pool related issues and difficulties immediately
- Remain attentive for the duration of assigned duties
- Support others in executing aquatics activities
- Role model and enforce silence during announcements
- Role model and enforce good manners during meals
- Role model and enforce good daily personal hygiene
- Be directly responsible for season ending area clean up
- Be on time for all scheduled meetings, activities, meals etc.
- Participate in regularly scheduled trainings and water work-outs
- Participate in the community Learn to swim week
- Maintain a minimum of 35 hours per week, not to exceed 40. (Schedules at the discretion of the Aquatics supervisor or Camp Director)
- Be provided with a hot lunch each day
- Anything else not specifically addressed that needs to be done to keep Camp Mason safe, fun, and on the leading edge of the camping industry

Requirements:

- # Aged 18 years or more
- # CPR, first aid, and life-guarding certification from either YMCA or Red Cross
- # Be able to start on June 18, 2007 - and stay through August 19, 2007
