



## Position: Zone Officer

Job Description overview: The Zone Officer is a Cabin Counselor who specializes in tracking and knowing the location of every camper under our care. This position requires confident leadership abilities, high levels of interpersonal communication and conflict resolution skills, good organizational skills, ability to see the big picture and a great deal of energy and physical stamina. Reports to the Zone Coordinator.

### Additionally, the Zone Officer will:

- Fulfill the responsibilities of a Cabin Counselor (exception of teaching or leading activities)
- Advise Camp Director on counselor morale and feedback
- Encourage all campers to actively engage in their activities
- Maintain professionalism over the radio
- Strive to have all campers accounted for within 10 minutes of the start of each activity period
- Be responsible for the use and upkeep of radios
- Assist in camp emergencies and other circumstances that may require radio communication
- Assist leadership with designing and implementing emergency and inclement weather plans
- Provide first aid and emergency care as needed, and know locations of first aid boxes
- Anything else not specifically addressed that needs to be done to keep Camp Mason safe, fun, and on the leading edge of the camping industry

### Requirements:

- Aged 18 years or more
- CPR and first aid certification
- Be physically fit
